Did You Know?

Ten Fun Facts About Coyotes

1. Coyotes love to play with each other, wrestling and throwing sticks to each other and playing with their collection of found objects—shoes, pens, sunglasses, old pop cans.
2. Coyotes mate for life, hunting together and sometimes having pups. If a coyote is injured or is sick, their mate will hunt for them and take care of them.
3. Coyotes organize themselves into packs (5-12 coyotes)
4. Only one litter of pups is born to every pack of coyotes.
5. The whole pack helps the mother take care of the pups. Aunts and uncles take part in feeding them, guarding them and teaching them.
6. Coyotes can run as fast as 64kph but usually trot at 4-6 kph
7. Coyotes like to conserve energy, so they have lots of naps.
8. Coyotes eat mostly mice, squirrels and rabbits. They also love cherries, apples, eggs and nuts.
9. Coyotes hunt mostly at night although you will see them out during the day in winter.
10. Coyotes wake up and go hunting when the Sun and Moon (and sometimes Venus, Mars and Jupiter) are either overhead or when they are hidden and it is very dark.
