# Did You Know?

## Ten Fun Facts About Frogs

1. When a frog swallows food, it pulls its eyes down into its socket to push the food down its throat.
2. Frogs do not drink water with their mouths; they absorb it directly through their permeable skin.
3. The North American wood frog can survive being frozen solid during winter, thawing out in spring.
4. Many frogs shed their skin once a week, and then they often eat the old skin.
5. Frogs have powerful back legs for leaping, with some jumping over 20 times their own body length.
6. Frogs exist on every continent except Antarctica.
7. The Goliath frog is the largest at over a foot long, while *Paedophryne amauensis* is just 7 millimetres long.
8. Frog saliva acts like a liquid to wrap around prey and a solid to grip it, allowing them to catch prey in milliseconds.
9. A group of frogs is called an army.
10. There are over 4,700 species of frogs!
