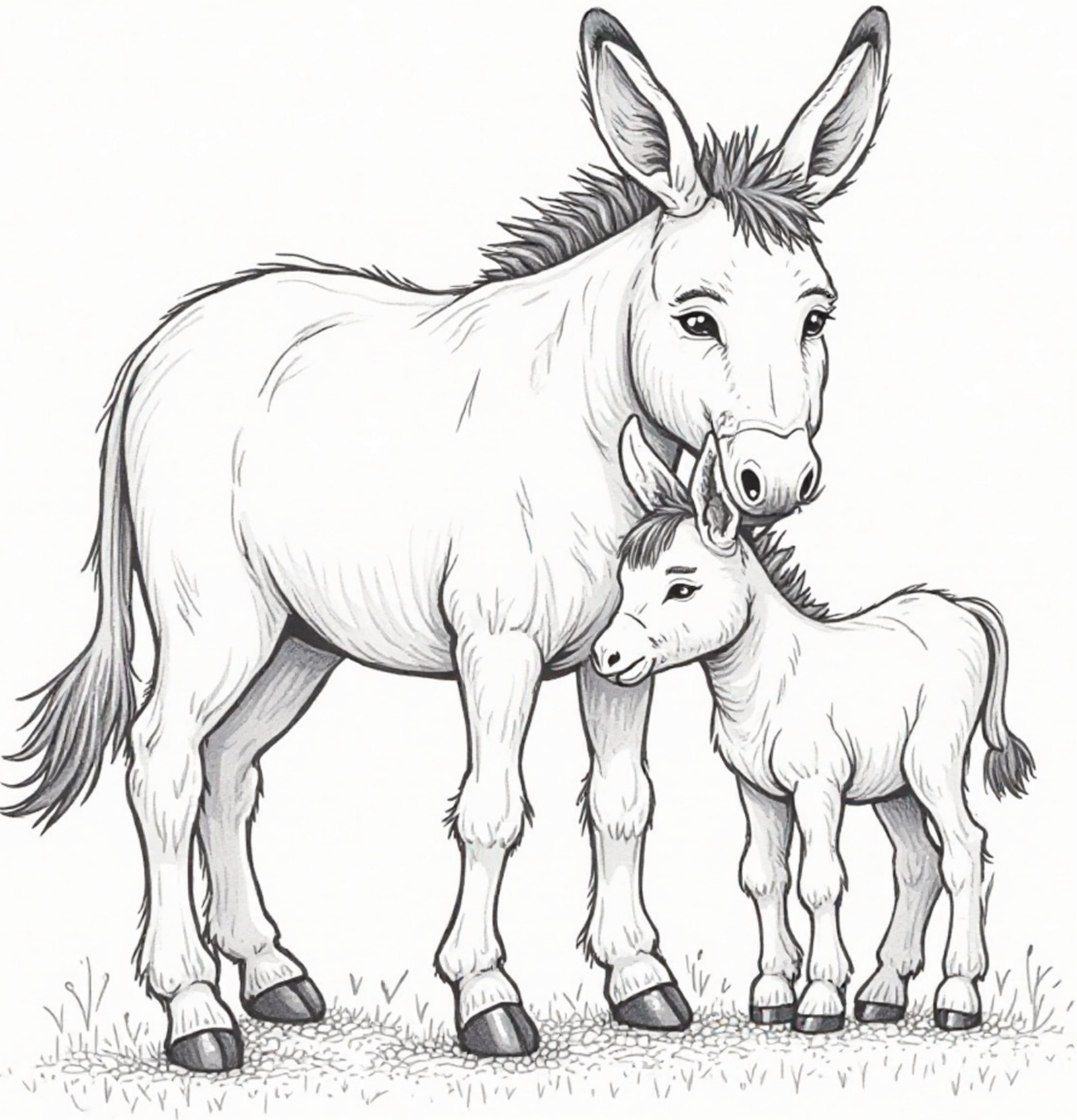
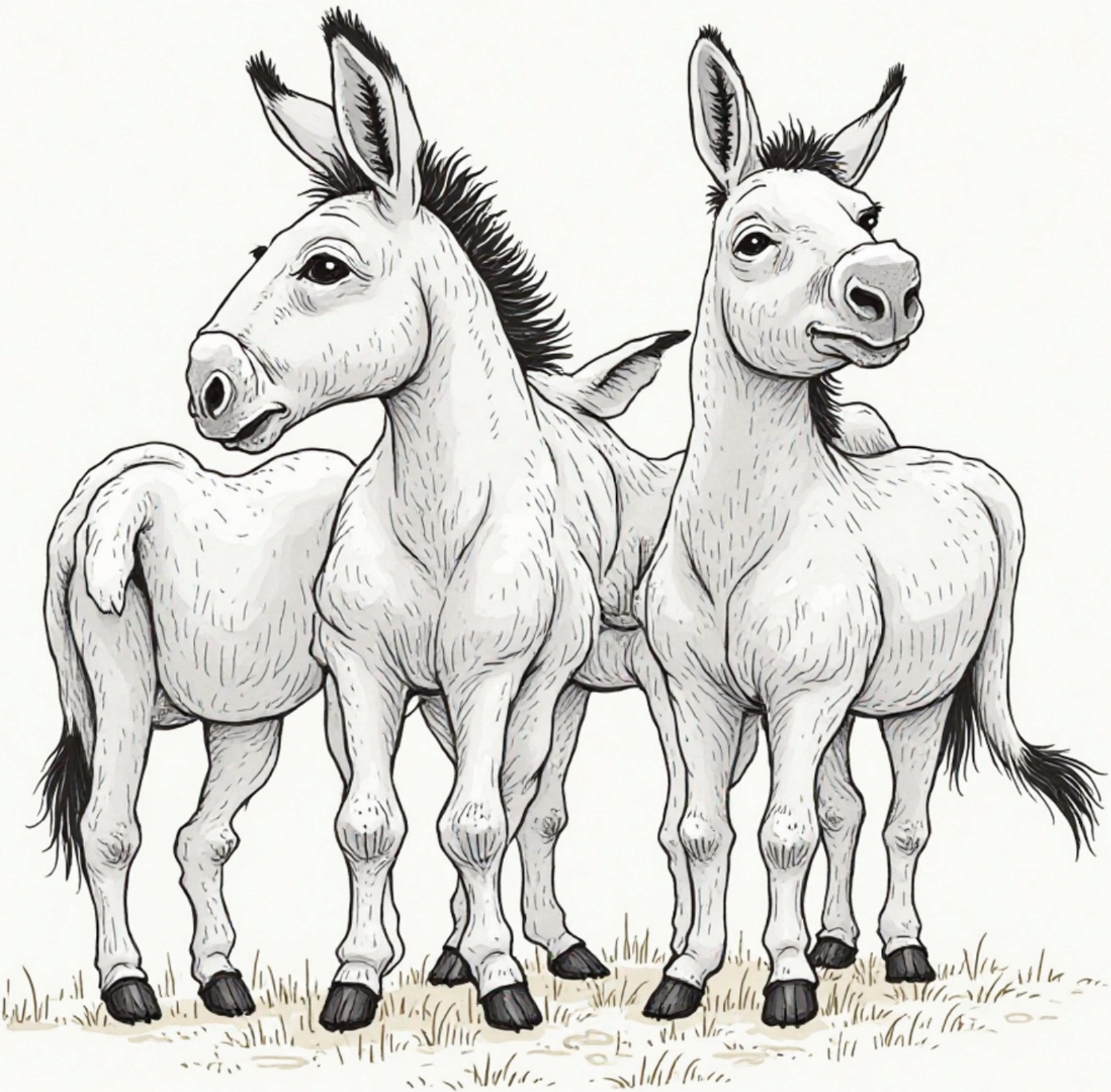

## Ten Fun Facts About Donkeys

1. Donkeys are highly intelligent and can remember places and other donkeys upwards of 25 years ago.
2. Donkeys rely more on their fight instinct than flight. They will assess situations before acting. This behavior helps them survive in harsh environments.
3. A donkey's bray is unique to them and helps other donkeys recognize one another. Their bray can be heard over 3 kilometers away.
4. Donkeys have been used as working animals for more than 5 000 years. With proper equipment and care, donkeys can carry up to 30% of their body weight.
5. Donkeys originated from the desert and are naturally adapted to hot and dry climates. Their body systems (digestive and feet) are built for survival in rough terrain.
6. Donkeys have large ears that help them hear over long distances. They are also used for temperate regulation.
7. Donkeys will form strong bonds with their companions. They dislike being separate and can show signs of stress and grief if their companion is out of sight or passes away.
8. Donkeys have their own breeds with more than 180 around the world.
9. Donkeys have adapted to a large range of climates and are found on every continent except Antarctica.
