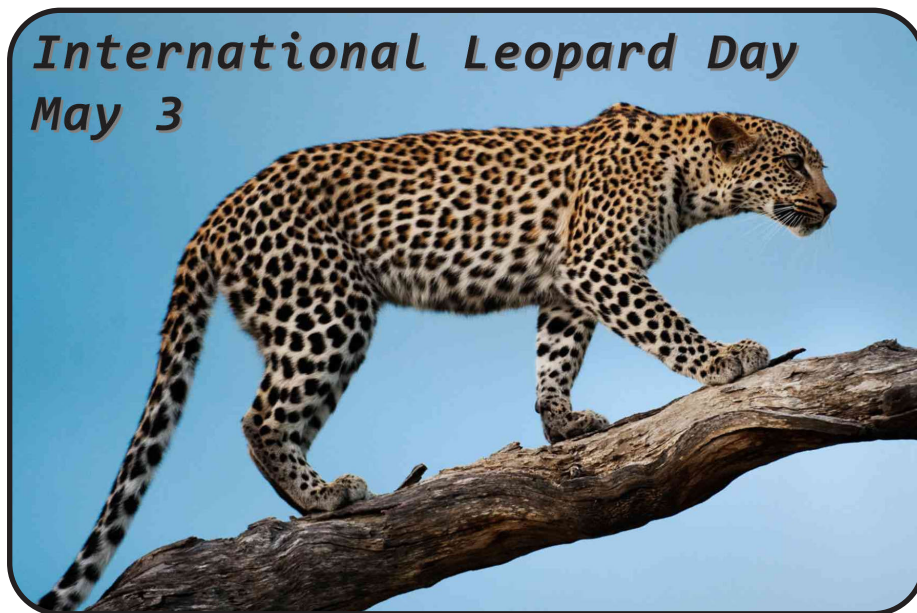
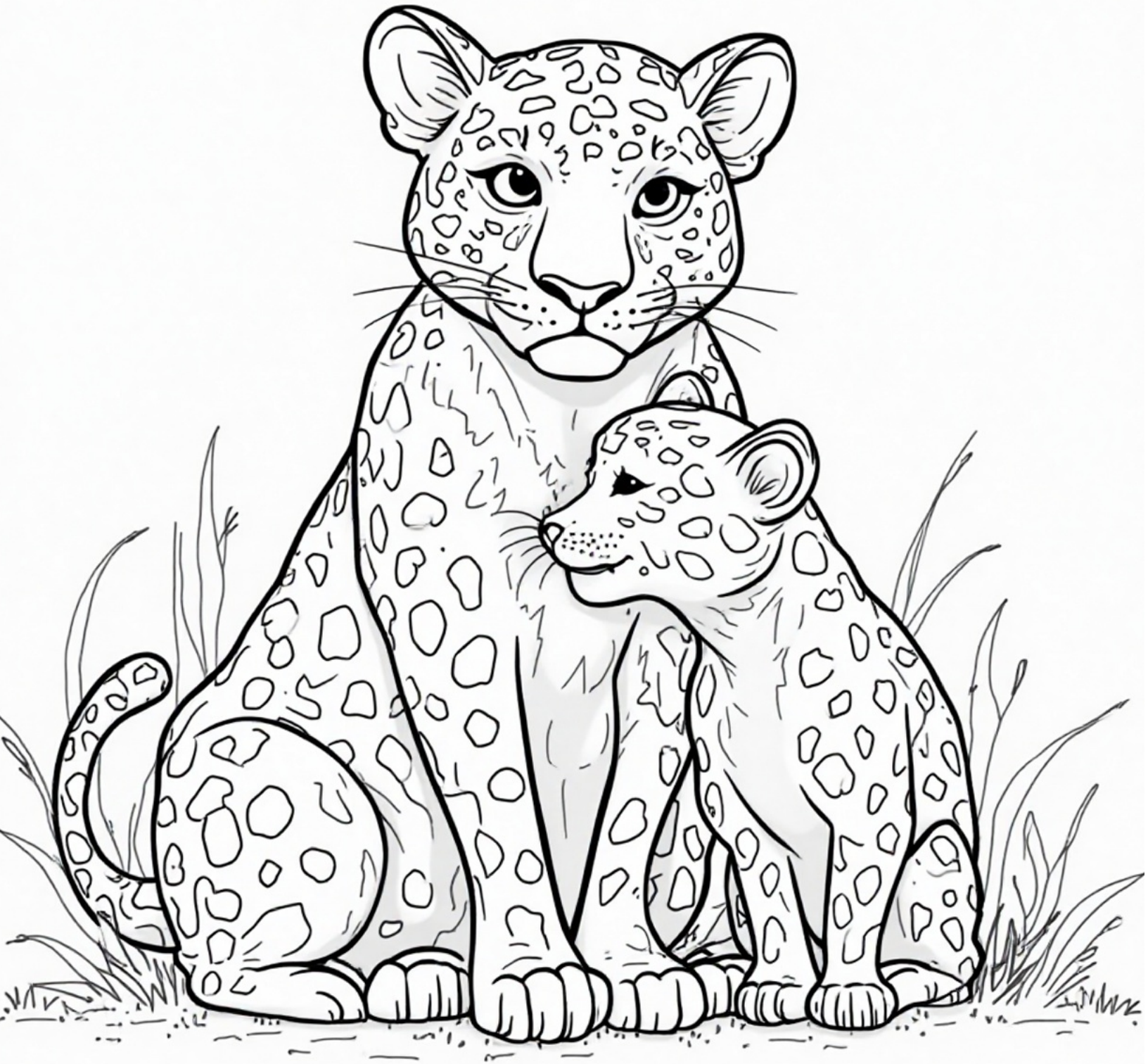

# Did You Know?

## Ten Fun Facts About Leopards

1. Leopards love to climb and are very comfortable in trees, often bringing their food up high to eat in peace.
2. Unlike lions, leopards prefer to live and hunt alone.
3. Leopards are mostly active at night, using their excellent night vision to hunt.
4. A leopard's coat has special dark spots shaped like roses, called rosettes, which help it blend in with trees and grass.
5. Some leopards have all-black fur, making their spots hard to see—these are often called black panthers.
6. Leopards have very long tails that they use for balance, acting like a tightrope walker's pole when running or jumping.
7. Leopards can live in many places, including deserts, mountains, and even near busy cities.
8. Leopards can leap about 3 metres (10 feet) vertically—that's higher than a basketball hoop.
9. Instead of roaring all the time, leopards make a raspy sound called "sawing" to mark their territory.
10. A female leopard can move her cubs to a new, safe den up to a mile away every day.
