Ten Fun Facts About Bears

1. Instead of true hibernation, bears enter "torpor," a deep sleep where their heart rate slows but they can still wake up.
2. A bear's sense of smell is far superior to a dog's, allowing them to detect food from several miles away.
3. Despite their heavy build, grizzlies can run faster than the fastest human, reaching speeds of 48 km per hour.
4. Wild brown bears have been observed using rocks to scratch itchy spots on their fur.
5. Grizzly cubs weigh less than a pound at birth, despite growing into massive adults.
6. Like humans, bears are plantigrade, meaning they walk on the soles of their feet, which allows them to stand upright.
7. Bears have complex social structures and use a range of vocalizations and scents to communicate with other bears in their territory.
8. Black bears, in particular, are adept at climbing trees, sometimes using them for protection or to build dens.
9. Black bear cubs love to play, including riding on tree saplings, playing on trampolines, and splashing in swimming pools.
10. Bears have the larger brain size of any carnivore.
